We are pleased to enclose for you our 2010 annual report. We trust you will find this material informative, engaging and inspiring. Some highlights from the past year include:

- 57,000 young participants positively impacted through our national school and community-based programs (including 5,956 young people in New South Wales)
- 580 primary and secondary schools across Australia engaged in Reach programs
- 14% increase in the number of Crew delivering programs and participating in Reach's Leadership Development program
- Delivery of our Fused Workshops in 3 new locations; Caroline Springs and Casey, Victoria and Redfern, New South Wales
- A four-year funding grant, worth \$4 million, was awarded by the Commonwealth Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations. The grant supports Reach's work with Indigenous young people and teachers across the nation.
- *Every Heart Beats True: The Jim Stynes Story* was released and raised \$100,000 for Reach
- Reach was a finalist in the \$5 million to \$20 million revenue category, in the 2010 PwC Transparency Awards
